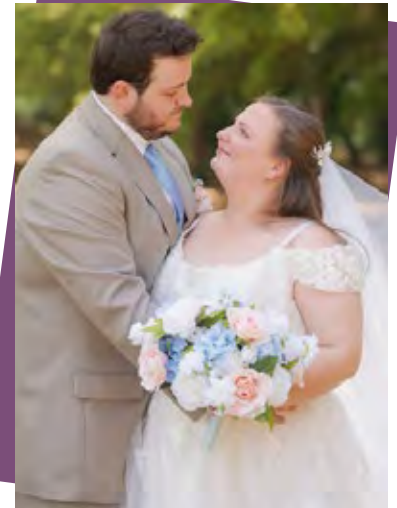
WEDDING DAY AT CALVARY

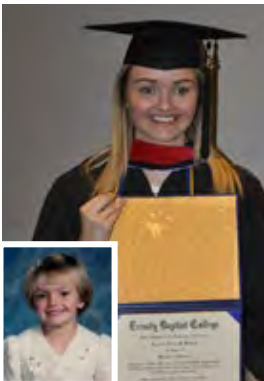

CALVARY'S NEXT P.A.G.E.

Calvary's Next P.A.G.E. (building your **Purpose with Attitude, Gratitude, and Effort**) program reflects our uniqueness. It is designed to build on the foundation established by each child's plan of care, assisting our young people graduating from high school and preparing them for the next phase of their lives. Calvary's long-term care plan ensures that our children do not age out when they turn 18. We believe we cannot call ourselves a long-term care program if our children, in whom we have invested so many years, are forced to leave simply because they reach the age of 18.

We explore various options with them, such as college, vocational training, military service, or finding a direct path to employment.

Upon graduation, they can stay at Calvary as long as they actively work towards the goals, we help them establish.

We aim to prepare our young adults for the transition to adulthood by further developing the foundational skills they acquired during their time at Calvary. This involves providing support and teaching essential skills such as goal setting, personal finance management, spiritual growth, interview skills, securing reliable transportation, guidance on healthcare, and basic life skills.



Our ultimate goal is to help them become well-rounded individuals—physically, emotionally, and spiritually grounded—so that they can build and maintain healthy relationships and contribute positively to our community.
